

THE NEXT DCN CHAIRMAN

Role of the Chairman and skills

Each branch of DCN is autonomous and conducts its own campaign activities, and the chairman's role is to support them.

The Chairman should also further the aims of DCN and develop the Network within the aims of the constitution.

DCN prefers a non-confrontational stance to work with local authorities and other groups to achieve improvements for cyclists, so the chairman should be prepared to work in this way.

The Chairman leads the Committee, who are elected at the AGM and meet three times a year. They include the Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Secretary

The Chairman will need to be informed about national cycling policy, the policies and campaigns of other groups to which the DCN is affiliated, and legislation on issues such as traffic and data protection.

A commitment and interest in promoting cycling for work, school and shopping journeys as well as for leisure is more important than the number of miles you cycle.
